



BURGUNDY BAG

EMBROIDERY SIZE : 15.5 x 23 cm

- **NEEDLEWORK SUPPLIES**

Special Mouliné stranded cotton thread ART 117
2 skeins 371 GREEN
1 skeins 209 PURPLE VIOLET
2 skeins 221 BROWN

Needle with round end
Scissors
DMC AIDA fabric : 6 cts - 2.4 pts/cm
Colour : ECRU
Size : 20 * 30 cm

- **SEWING SUPPLIES**

Burgundy fabric
For the bag : 2 pieces of 30 * 30 cm
For the sicky linings : 2 pieces of 12 * 30 cm
For the bag handles :2 pieces of 7 * 96 cm
For the bag depth : 2 pieces of 7 * 30 cm
1 piece of 7 * 30 cm

- **SEWING SUPPLIES**

Burgundy sewingg thread
Sewing machine
Pins
Scissoss
Iron
Kapok

- **STITCHES USED**

Cross stitch with 6 strands
Straight stitch

- **INSTRUCTIONS**

Draw the pieces of fabric :
For the bag, 2 rectangles of 26.5 * 25 cm
For the sticky linings, 2 rectangles of 26.5 * 10 cm
For the bag handles, 2 rectangles of 6 * 90 cm
For the bag depth (sides), 2 rectangles of 3 * 25 cm
For the bag depth (bottom), 1 rectangle of 3 * 26.5 cm
Cut and let 2 cm around.

Define the middle of the aida fabric and put a mark with a pin.
Embroider the design, beginning by the middle of the chart (point of intersection between the 2 black arrows), and follow the chart instructions



Iron the back side of the embroidery

For the bag :

Put the bag depth (2 pieces) face to face in the bag and sew the outlines

Put the rectangles of the sticky linings face to face and sew the sides on the width

Make a hem of 1 cm and sew by using the arrowhead stitch

Fold the pieces of the bag handles on the length face to face and sew both sides.

Put the bag handles face to face at 2 cm from the side

Maintain with some stitches

Put the sticky lining in the bag face to face and sew all around the top of the bag, bag handles included

Iron and turn back

Put the embroidery on the middle of the bag at 7 cm from the sides
