

Diagonal Rib Swirl Beanie with Pompom

Skill Level: Advanced



Materials

- 1 - 50g ball DMC Woolly, color 071
- US 3 (3 or 3.25 mm) 16" circular knitting needle
- Yarn needle

Abbreviations

Sl - Slip
St/s – stitch/es
M1 – Make one

Notes:

- The top is worked flat in welts (horizontal ribbing). Increases and decreases will create a diagonal fabric.
- The bottom band is picked up and knit in Garter stitch (knit every st, every row).

Beanie Instructions

Beanie Top

With DMC Woolly color 071, cast on 56 sts.

Row 1: Knit all sts.

Row 2: Purl all sts.

Row 3: Sl1 knitwise, M1, knit until 2 sts remain, k2tog.

Row 4: Purl all sts.

Row 5: Sl1 purlwise, M1, purl until 2 sts remain, p2tog.

Row 6: Knit all sts.

Row 7: Same as Row 5



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Row 8: Same as Row 6
Row 9: Same as Row 3.
Row 10: Same as Row 4.
Row 11: Same as Row 3.
Row 12: Same as Row 4

Repeat Rows 5 – 12 until you have a total of 20 pair of welts.
Bind off all sts.

Bottom Band

Pick up and knit 84 sts along one side.
Work in Garter St for 34 rows.
Bind off all sts.

Finishing

Sew seam matching knit welt to knit welt and purl welt to purl welt.
Gather the top and secure.
Make a pom-pom and attach it to the top of the beanie.
Weave in the ends.



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
